Mr. Zev Goldrich currently serves as the Chief Human Capital Officer for Naval Intelligence reporting to the Deputy Director of Naval Intelligence (DDNI) via the Assistant Deputy Director of Naval Intelligence (ADDNI). He is the key advisor and lead management official for developing, recommending, and implementing human capital programs, strategies and policies for the Naval Intelligence civilian community. From 2014-2017, he served as the Director of Civilian Human Resources overseeing implementation and management of Defense Civilian Intelligence Personnel System (DCIPS) programs and policies.

He was appointed to the Defense Intelligence Senior Level (DISL) in December 2017.

From 2012-2014, Mr. Goldrich supported the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) as the Director, Strategic Management, overseeing agency-wide strategic planning and execution, and the Deputy Director, Human Resources, responsible for providing human capital strategy, policy and operational support to DFAS and additional Department of Defense agencies. From 2003-2011, Mr. Goldrich served in a variety of human capital roles across the Department of Defense and as a consultant at BearingPoint Consulting.
