

Neil W. T. Hogg



**Assistant Deputy Chief of Naval Operations
Integration of Capabilities and Resources
Office of the Chief of Naval Operations**

Mr. Hogg was promoted to Assistant Deputy Chief of Naval Operations for Integration of Capabilities and Resources on the staff of the Chief of Naval Operations in October 2017. His mission is to exercise centralized supervision of Navy warfare requirements, allocation of resources, program planning, and study efforts to ensure integration of planning, programming, budgeting, and assessments within OPNAV and the management echelons subordinate to CNO. Mr. Hogg manages the development of the Navy's Program Objective Memorandum (POM), with an annual TOA of over \$130B to deliver a fiscally balanced annual budget with increased capability and capacity for the CNO and Combatant Commanders worldwide.

Mr. Hogg entered the Senior Executive Service in December 2011 after a career as a Naval Aviator beginning with his 1981 graduation from the U.S. Naval Academy, and included 4,000 flight hours and three Pentagon tours specifically working the Department of the Navy (DON) program and budget. His initial SES assignment was as the Deputy Director, Program and Financial Control, Office of the Under Secretary of Defense (Comptroller). Mr. Hogg assured the timely processing and control of program budget decisions and oversaw data base reconciliations to remain within the Department of Defense's funding limits. Mr. Hogg assumed his duties as Director of the Program/Budget Coordination Division in June, 2014. In this capacity, he assisted in the oversight of budget formulation and execution of over \$165 billion annually for the Navy and United States Marine Corps. He was responsible for implementing overall budget strategies; promulgating budget formulation guidance; developing Navy, Marine Corps, and Secretariat procedures for the Departmental resource decision-making process; monitoring and continuously evaluating budget execution performance; processing fund allocations for the entire Department of the Navy; establishing budget controls; and development and operation of Information Technology systems in support of the budget process. Additionally from June 2005 to December 2011 he served as the Deputy Director for the Program/Budget Coordination Division.

During his tenure as a Naval Officer, his assignments were both afloat and ashore. His operational tours included service in USS NASSAU (LHA 4), multiple tours on various surface combatants as a SH-60B helicopter pilot and Commanding Officer of the “Grandmasters” of Helicopter Anti-Submarine Light (HSL) Squadron 46. Under his command the Grandmasters were selected as the 1999 Commander Naval Air Forces Atlantic Fleet Battle Efficiency Winner’s, they also earned the Commander Helicopter Anti-Submarine Light Wing Atlantic Fleet Maintenance Excellence Award for 1999.

Mr. Hogg graduated from the U.S. Naval Academy in 1981 with a Bachelor of Science degree in History. He holds a Master’s degree in National Security and Strategic Studies from the Naval War College in Newport, Rhode Island. Mr. Hogg has received various personal awards, including the Legion of Merit, the Department of the Navy Superior Civilian Service Award and Meritorious Civilian Service Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal with two gold stars, and the Single Action Air Medal.
