Assistant Deputy Chief of Naval Operations for Warfare Systems (OPNAV N9B)

Mr. Lluy assumed his current position as the Assistant Deputy Chief of Naval Operations for Warfare Systems (N9B) in June 2016. In this capacity, Mr. Lluy acts as the principal advisor to Deputy, Chief of Naval Operations (N9) for determination of warfare requirements and the integration of naval warfare systems. Mr. Lluy also provides professional and technical advice on program and budget matters pertaining to naval warfare programs and he exercises centralized coordination in the preparation, preview, presentation, and subsequent issuance of decisions on Navy programs and plans.

Prior to his current assignment, Mr. Lluy was the Director, Warfare Integration Division (N9I) from January 2016 to June 2016. As the Director he was responsible for assessing the warfighting investment priorities and integration across R&D procurement, readiness, and manpower portfolios.

Previously, he served as the Deputy Director, Air Warfare Division (N98B) where he was responsible for the division's programming and budgeting, portfolio management, plans and studies, and internal business processes. Specifically, he managed all N98 budgeting and programming activities relating to naval aviation investment, readiness and manpower accounts.

Additionally, Mr. Lluy served as the Deputy Budget Director at the Department of Energy (DOE) from June 2012 to August 2013. In this capacity, he led a budget division responsible for a wide-range of financial duties including independent analytical support to the Secretary of Energy on budget formulation and execution matters, internal coordination and integration of the annual DOE budget submission, and final roll-out of the Department's annual budget request to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB).

Prior to joining the Senior Executive Service, Mr. Lluy had a distinguished 27-year career as a commissioned officer and naval aviator in the United States Navy where he served in a variety of operational and staff assignments. From 2008-2011 he served as Branch Director and later, acting Deputy Director of Warfare Integration and Programming Division (OPNAV N8F). His operational assignments included multiple flying tours in various Navy rotary-wing squadrons culminating in command of the Navy's largest aviation wing from 2006-2008.

Mr. Lluy earned a Bachelor of Science degree from the United States Naval Academy, and a Master of Arts in National Security Affairs from the Naval Postgraduate School. He has received numerous awards throughout his career including the Legion of Merit and Bronze Star.
