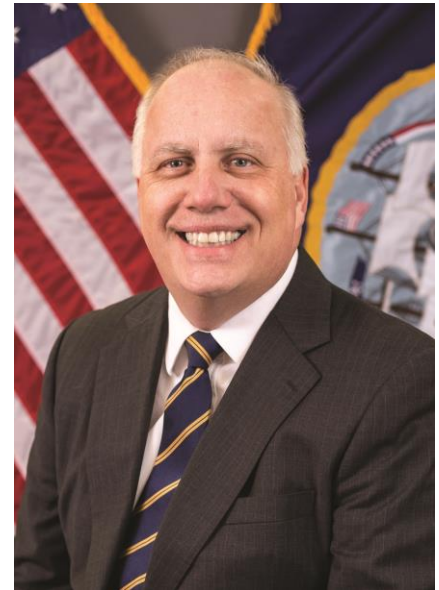

Kurt J. Wendelken
