

# PSAB Activities – January 2010

## Appeals Processed by Group & Service

- 50 Appeals decided in January
  - 21 Clearances granted / reinstated (42%)
  - 29 Clearances denied / revoked (58%)
- 14 Personnel appealed directly to the PSAB
  - 3 Clearances granted / reinstated (21%)
- 36 Personnel appealed personally before an administrative judge
  - 18 Clearances granted / reinstated (50%)
- Average days to process / decide an appeal – **18**
  - From date of arrival to date of decision




# PSAB Activities – January 2010


## Sensitive Compartmented Information (SCI) Related Appeals

- 5 appeals involved SCI access eligibility determinations
  - 2 appeals were granted SCI access eligibility
  - 3 appeal was denied SCI access eligibility
    - 2 denied appeal had two issues

Appeals by grade / affiliation




Denied appeal concerns



# PSAB Activities – January 2010

## Issues Present in Denied Appeals

- Financial concerns present in 62% of denied appeals (18 of 29)
  - 5 denied appeals had two concerns present
  - 4 denied appeal had three concerns present



# PSAB Activities – January 2010

## DOHA vs. Direct Appeals – Processing Time & Results

- Security clearance eligibility was granted / reinstated in 42% of the appeals decided (21)

↓ PSAB processed appeals in an average of 18 days

Calculated from PSAB arrival to PSAB decision date

- Type of appeal submitted impacts total processing – Direct vs. DOHA
  - Direct appeals took an average of 79 days to process
  - DOHA appeals took an average of 159 days to process
    - Calculated from date of letter of notification to date of PSAB decision
