1. Per reference (a) the Defense Security Service Academy has developed a short web-based training module to provide an overview of the new Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI) framework. The training is an awareness of the overhaul of the pending changes to the current requirements for the marking, safeguarding, and dissemination of CUI, most commonly known type of CUI is For Official Use Only. The new CUI framework will cover a broader scope of information and impact a greater number of personnel that will have to comply with new marking, safeguarding, dissemination, and decontrol requirements, once implemented. Therefore, commands are highly encouraged to ensure all Department of the Navy personnel, military and civilian, take the training available at <https://enrol.dss.mil/courseware/cui>.

2. CUI requirements outlined in reference (b) remain in effect, until national and Department of Defense CUI policy is published, as previously indicated in reference (c).

3. Addressees are requested to disseminate this information to subordinate commands.



The Defense Security Service Academy (DSSA) has developed a short, web-based course on CUI awareness to provide an overview of the CUI Framework mandated by reference (a). This online course will help prepare DoD personnel for the expected implementation of the new CUI Framework and its impact on the designation, marking, safeguarding, and dissemination of unclassified sensitive material, most commonly known as "For Official Use Only." The training is hosted at the DSSA website at <https://enrol.dss.mil/courseware/cui>.

Because CUI will potentially affect every DoD employee and military service member, we encourage you to ensure all personnel working with sensitive unclassified information take this training. Until national CUI policy is published, the current requirements for handling such information remain as stated in appendix 3 of reference (b).
