July 8th-August 30th Industrial Security Oversight Certification (ISOC) Beta Test

What: Industrial Security Oversight Certification Beta Test
DSS CDSE will be conducting a beta test for ISOC. The ISOC beta test is the opportunity for DoD Industrial security professionals to be the first wave in leading the newest SPED Specialty Certification.

The ISOC is a specialty certification associated with the Security Professional Education Development (SPED) Program.

The Beta Test measures candidates' knowledge on such competencies as: information security, classification management, incident response, information assurance/cybersecurity, personnel security, physical security, industrial security, general security, the National Industrial Security Program, foundational concepts in facility security and clearance, general safeguard requirements, facility surveys, and inspections.



Why:

- Play a role in professionalizing our security workforce by assisting with development of the final production version of the certification assessment.
- Be the first in DoD to achieve this specialty certification.
- Participants who achieve a passing score, based on the final production version of the ISOC assessment, will be forwarded for conferral to USD(I).

When: Registration begins July 8 – **August 16 (Extended)**. Testing is from August 1-30.

Where: Any authorized Pearson VUE Testing Center in CONUS or OCONUS.

Who: ISOC beta test is open only to DoD civilians and military.
