1. I hereby set aside the nonjudicial punishment (NJP) proceedings in the case of AEAA Aaron Alexis. All rights, privileges, and property affected by virtue of this execution of this punishment shall be restored. Per reference (a), I request that you remove from AEAA Aaron Alexis's official record all references to NJP hearing which has been set aside. Request copy-to addressees take appropriate restorative action in case of AEAA Aaron Alexis and notify me and the member concerned when completed.

- a. Name: AEAA Aaron Alexis, USN, (b) (6)
- b. Date of NJP: 12 July 09
- c. Imposing Command: Fleet Logistics Support Squadron, FOUR SIX
- d. Offenses of which member was found guilty: Article 134
- e. Punishment Awarded: Reduction in Rate to pay grade E-2

f. Rationale for set aside: Member appealed the case and in light of new facts surrounding the case, the Commanding Officer has decided that the NJP should be set aside. There was insufficient evidence confirming he was intoxicated per the MILSPERMAN 1900.

g. Unusual circumstance (s): Reserve Unit in BRAC status.
