**Summary Narrative**

On Saturday 09-04-10 at approximately 1849 hrs I, Officer **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** working W237, was dispatched to an apt complex, Orion at Oak Hill Apts, at **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** in reference to a shots fired call. The details of the call stated "CP STS SHE HEARD A 'POP' & SAW SMOKE & DUST; NOW SEES THAT THERE IS A HOLE IN HER FLOOR & ANOTHER IN HER CEILING; BELIEVES SOMEONE JUST SHOT INTO HER APT; DID NOT SEE ANYTHING OR ANYONE; CP HAS MOVED AWAY FROM AREA WHERE HOLES ARE; CONTACT CP". Upon arrival I met with the witness who was inside her apt and visibly shaken up.

She told that she was sitting in a chair when she heard the loud pop and saw the dust. She then saw that there was a hole in her floor just a couple of feet from where she was sitting while shredding papers and a hole in the ceiling. She told me that she believed someone had shot a bullet through her apt. She then told me that no one from downstairs had come up to talk to her and she had not gone down. She also told me that her downstairs neighbor ARR (Alexis, Aaron) has called the police several times on her for being loud however the police always said they didn't hear anything and no action was taken. She said that several days ago Aaron confronted her in the parking lot about making too much noise. **(b) (6)** told me that she is terrified of Aaron and feels that this was done intentionally. I then relocated to apt and attempted to make contact with Aaron 3 separate times by knocking on his door and I received no response.

Due to the fact that someone could be hurt I called FD for a possible forced entry however when FD arrived Aaron came outside on his own. I made contact with Aaron who informed me that he did have a gun and he said that he was cleaning it when it went off. He said that he was trying to clean his gun while cooking and that his hands were slippery. He told me that he began to take the gun apart when his hands slipped and pulled the trigger discharging a round into the ceiling. He said he was sitting on the floor facing toward the large couch in his living room. When asked why he didn't call police or go check on the resident above him, Aaron said that he didn't think

it went all the way through since he couldn't see any light through the hole. In regards to the noise he said he thought that people would just think it was a firecracker. I then asked why he wouldn't answer the door when I knocked and he said that he thought it was just his upstairs neighbor and he didn't want to talk to her because she is always making noise. While inside the apt I looked at the gun which was taken apart at this time. A gun cleaning kit was located next to the gun and the gun was covered in oil.

After investigating the situation, Aaron was taken to 350 W. Belknap and booked. A report was generated.

I then relocated to apt #2023 and attempted to make contact with Aaron 3 separate times by knocking on his door and I received no response.

Due to the fact that someone could be hurt I called FD for a possible forced entry and another unit, however when FD arrived Aaron came outside on his own (approximately 20 mins after I last knocked on the door). Assist Officer T Sherlock 3866 working W245 and I made contact with Aaron who informed us that he did have a gun and he said that he was attempting to clean the gun when it went off. He said that he was trying to clean his gun while cooking and that his hands were slippery. He told me that he began to take the gun apart when his hands slipped and pulled the trigger discharging a round into the ceiling. He said he was sitting on the floor facing toward the large couch in his living room. When asked why he didn't call police or go check on the resident above him, Aaron said that he didn't think it went all the way through since he couldn't see any light through the hole. In regards to the noise he said he thought that people would just think it was a firecracker. I then asked why he wouldn't answer the door when I knocked and he said that he thought it was just his upstairs neighbor and he didn't want to talk to her because she is always making noise. While inside the apt I looked at the gun which was taken apart at this time. A gun cleaning kit was located next to the gun and the gun was covered in oil.

CSSU Officer (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) working U489 made the scene and took several pictures and took the gun and fired casing as evidence. We located the fired casing inside a box that was located next to where Aaron said he was when the gun went off.

Aaron recklessly discharged a firearm in the city limits of Fort Worth, which currently has an approximate population of 750,000+. Due to the fact that those actions caused a breach of the peace by placing (b) (6) in extreme fear for her safety he was arrested and transported to 350 W. Belknap for Discharge of Firearm in Certain Municipalities.

Aaron is in the Navy and his immediate supervisor was notified of the situation.

Acting (b) (6) was notified and made the scene.

Det Phillips was notified and was spoken with over the phone by (b) (6). Det (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was in agreement with the charge and course of action.

**Narrative**

On Sunday, 09-05-2010, Detective SA (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) working W822 was assigned this case for follow up investigation. Detective (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) met with the ARR, Aaron Alexis at 1115 hours to interview the ARR at MLEC. Detective (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) mirandized the ARR at 1115 hours and the ARR signed the written miranda warning indicating he understood his rights. Detective (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) asked the ARR if he was in the military and if he had spent any time overseas. The ARR advised he was active Navy and had not spent anytime overseas and that his current assignment was that of an aircraft tech. Detective (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) asked the ARR if he had any firearms training and how many hours. The ARR stated that he had one day consisting of two or three hours of firearms training during basic training in the military. Detective Phillips asked the ARR if he knew how to clear a weapon to which he replied "yes" and then invoked his rights to counsel stating, " I know where this is going". Detective (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) ended the interview stating that Detective would be filing the case for Discharging a Firearm within a Municipality and asked the ARR who his commanding officer was. The ARR refused to answer stating he was invoking his rights. After review of this case, I believe the elements are met for the offense and will be presenting the case to the Tarrant County District Attorney for filing.

No further information at this time. Detective (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) recommends this case be closed and cleared by arrest. Sgt. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)

#### Narrative

On Saturday, September 4, 2010 I, CSSU Officer (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) working U489 was dispatched to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (b) (6), (b) (7) (C) (Orion at Oak Hill Apartment Complex) in reference to a Shooting. I was dispatched at 2000 hours and I arrived on scene at 2014 hours.

Upon my arrival on scene, I met with Corporal (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and Officer (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) I was advised a male resident had reportedly fired a handgun inside Apartment (b) (6) which is located on the second floor of Building 20 (inside the apartment complex). The resident was identified as-(Alexis, Aaron b/m 5-9-79). It was reported a single shot penetrated through the ceiling of Apartment #2023 and through the floor of Apartment (b) (6) located on the third floor (directly above (b) (6)). Officer (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) informed me that no one had been injured. A female resident in Apartment (b) (6) was reportedly seated at her desk (near the projectile's point of entry) when the incident occurred. The female resident was identified as-(b) (6)). Officer (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) obtained a signed Consent to Search form from Mr. Alexis.

At 2023 hours, I began a series of digital images (photographs) depicting the scene as observed and continuing throughout the investigation.

I met with (b) (6) inside Apartment (b) (6). I was directed to an apparent bullet defect (hole) in the floor and carpet located in the living area. The defect was several feet from a desk and chair. I observed a corresponding defect in the ceiling above. (The projectile was not recovered).

I relocated downstairs to Apartment (b) (6). I observed the floor plan of the apartment was similar to Apartment (b) (6) above. A handgun was located on the carpet in the living room area. It was disassembled and the handgun components were placed on a single paper towel located on top of the carpet. The components appeared to be heavily oiled. A gun cleaning kit was open and located next to the handgun components. The firearm was a black 40 caliber semi-automatic handgun, Model: Cougar 8000 as manufactured by Stoeger Industries with Serial #T649-07-D016344. A single magazine was located on the floor next to the paper towel. The magazine contained (11) unfired cartridges bearing the headstamp (Hornady 40:S&W). A single unfired cartridge was located next to the magazine with the same headstamp. A single fired casing was located inside a large cardboard box in the corner of the living area. The head stamp on the casing was consistent with those on the cartridges. I observed an apparent bullet defect on the ceiling above the location of the disassembled handgun. The position of the defect appeared to correspond with the defect observed in the floor of Apartment (b) (6).

I collected the handgun components and cartridge (Item #1) and the fired casing (Item #2). The items were secured in the CSSU vehicle.
