k. Comments of the Commanding Officer: AE3 Alexis has continued to perform at a subpar level due to his involvement with the authorities and the ongoing issues concerning arriving on time to work. Our squadron has given him multiple opportunities to correct his deficiencies. Our (b) (6) has spoken at length with AE3 Alexis and tried to counsel him into making better decisions. From his initial NJP in 2008 to his multiple violations regarding NAVPERS 1070/613's, we have tried to counsel him and give him chances to succeed in our squadron. His (b) (6) and (b) (6) spend an enormous amount of time attending to his deficiencies when their efforts could be used for positive means in the squadron. I hoped his first involvement with law enforcement would serve as a wake-up call to him; however, his latest charge with the Fort Worth Police Department says otherwise. His lack of care for his neighbor in the incident says a great deal to his character and his actions are not consistent with the integrity the U.S. Navy expects. He has refused to take advice from all levels of his Chain of Command and I see no future for him in the U.S. Navy. AM3 Alexis has not upheld the Navy Core Values of Honor, Courage, and Commitment. AE3 Alexis should be Administratively Separated from the Navy with a General discharge.
