RESULTS OF INTERVIEW OF (b) (6), CIV

1. On 24SEP13 Reporting Agent (RA) and Special Agent (SA) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) interviewed (b) (6) Front Desk Clerk, Naval Gateway Inn and Suites (NGIS), NAVSTA Newport, RI, regarding her knowledge and interaction with Aaron ALEXIS, CIV (S/ALEXIS), while staying at NGIS, Newport, RI in early August 2013. (b) (6) stated she worked the front desk at building 1312 at NGIS, NAVSTA Newport, RI on 06AUG13. (b) (6) explained upon coming on shift she read the log from previous shifts as NGIS protocol requires. (b) (6) recalled reading entries about S/ALEXIS written by her co-worker who had worked a previous shift, (b) (6), Night Auditor, which noted an incident regarding S/ALEXIS having taken apart his bed and other items in his room. The log, according to (b) (6), also documented reports S/ALEXIS made of hearing voices, stating three individuals were following him and had a machine they directed toward him, and reports of loud disruption while he was trying to sleep.
2. At around 1415, according to (b) (6), S/ALEXIS came to the front desk to get a key to his room on the first floor of one of the NGIS buildings. (b) (6) could not recall if it was building 442 or 443. (b) (6) stated S/ALEXIS politely stated he had moved rooms and his key did not work. (b) (6) gave him a new key. (b) (6) stated S/ALEXIS appeared normal, lucid and polite.
3. At approximately 2046, (b) (6) received a call from S/ALEXIS' supervisor (b) (6) at the front desk on the house line phone, (b) (6) the phone line generally used to transfer calls to guests. According to (b) (6), (b) (6) stated she was concerned that S/ALEXIS might hurt himself or others. (b) (6) explained (b) (6) stated S/ALEXIS was a reservist doing information technology (IT) related work for the company she works for. (b) (6) could not recall the name of the company. (b) (6) stated (b) (6) explained S/ALEXIS had a security clearance and asked (b) (6) why he was doing the things he was doing. (b) (6) stated she responded by reading and explaining the logs which documented S/ALEXIS' behavior from previous shifts. (b) (6), according to (b) (6), stated another supervisor she works with may want call the front desk at NGIS to talk about the same issue. (b) (6) took down phone numbers for both (b) (6) and another supervisor by the name of (b) (6). (b) (6) stated she did not make or receive and phone calls from either individual after she hung up with (b) (6).
4. (b) (6) stated at around 2100, once she got off of the phone with

(b) (6) she called (b) (6), Manager at NGIS. (b) (6) stated she explained the conversation she had with (b) (6) to (b) (6). According to (b) (6) told her to call Base Security and report the issue. (b) (6) stated as soon as she got off the phone with (b) (6), she called NAVSTA Newport Base Police and relayed that she wanted to report some information pertaining to the noise complaint issues they received regarding S/ALEXIS earlier that day/the day prior. (b) (6) stated at around 2105 (b) (6), USN, and (b) (6), USN, came to NGIS building 1312 to talk to her. (b) (6) stated she gave the MAS a background on what had happened with S/ALEXIS and explained the conversation she had with S/ALEXIS' supervisor (b) (6). According to (b) (6), she told (b) (6) and (b) (6) (b) (6) that (b) (6) expressed concern that S/ALEXIS may harm himself or others. After relaying this to the (b) (6) (b) (6) stated she asked the (b) (6) if they were going to check on S/ALEXIS. (b) (6) stated (b) (6) stated they did not intend on checking on S/ALEXIS because he was not doing anything at the moment. According to (b) (6), the (b) (6) told her they would listen out for any issues with S/ALEXIS and asked her to call them if S/ALEXIS became a problem. (b) (6) stated the (b) (6) left building 1312 shortly after and she did not receive any more calls or complaints from or about S/ALEXIS for the duration of her shift. (b) (6) stated she felt dissatisfied with the fact that the (b) (6) stated they were not going to check on S/ALEXIS. (b) (6) stated she came back into work a day or two later and found out that S/ALEXIS had checked out.

5. (b) (6) explained her coworker (b) (6), Front Desk Clerk, NGIS, was working with her on 06AUG13. (b) (6) stated (b) (6) was present when she called the Base Police to report the information relayed by (b) (6) following the conversation with (b) (6). (b) (6) further stated (b) (6) was also present when she explained the situation and reported that (b) (6) had concerns S/ALEXIS might harm himself or others to (b) (6) and (b) (6) in person.

6. (b) (6) did not contact NCIS regarding S/ALEXIS at any point regarding this issue. She explained she was not aware of any NGIS personnel who called NCIS regarding S/ALEXIS during this time period.
