RESULTS OF INTERVIEW OF (b) (6), USN

1. On 24SEP13 Reporting Agent (RA) interviewed (b) (6), USN, NAVSTA Newport, RI, regarding his interaction with Aaron ALEXIS, CIV (S/ALEXIS), while staying at the Navy Gateway Inn and Suites (NGIS) located on NAVSTA Newport, RI. (b) (6) could not recall the specific date of his interaction with S/ALEXIS, but explained he believes it was the second night that S/ALEXIS stayed at NGIS in Newport in early August 2013. (b) (6) stated he was on duty patrolling NAVSTA Newport, RI that evening in early August 2013. (b) (6), along with (b) (6), USN, received a dispatch call regarding a noise complaint at NGIS and were directed by the dispatcher to report to the front desk and obtain further information from the reception clerk. (b) (6) explained he and (b) (6) responded to NGIS building 1312 at approximately 2100-2130. Upon entering the building, they made contact with a woman who was working at the reception desk. (b) (6) explained he did not get the woman's name. (b) (6) asked the woman about the call and the woman explained that one of their guests, S/ALEXIS, had been disruptive and expressed noise complaints earlier that day so they moved his room. (b) (6) stated the woman showed (b) (6) and (b) (6) the hand-written log documenting the issue. (b) (6) described the log as short hand notes which appeared to be written down in a quick manner. The log, according to (b) (6), described how S/ALEXIS walked up and down the hallway yelling about other guests making noise. The woman also explained that S/ALEXIS had taken apart his bed and other items in his room, but since he did not cause any permanent damage, NGIS did not report it. The woman explained she had also received a call from one of S/ALEXIS' coworkers expressing concern that S/ALEXIS was not sleeping. (b) (6) explained the woman did not say who the coworker that called was or what company he/she was from. (b) (6) stated the woman did not tell him that the caller believed S/ALEXIS was a threat in any way. The woman gave (b) (6) and (b) (6) the new room number where S/ALEXIS had been moved.

2. (b) (6) explained he and (b) (6) then went to S/ALEXIS' new room located on the first floor of building 443 on NAVSTA Newport, RI. (b) (6) knocked on the door and S/ALEXIS opened it and greeted the (b) (6). (b) (6) explained it did not appear that S/ALEXIS expected a visit by Base Police. S/ALEXIS did not have a shirt on and had his belt unbuckled when he answered the door. (b) (6) then obtained information from S/ALEXIS' Naval Underwater Warfare Center (NUWC) temporary badge. (b) (6) recorded S/ALEXIS' first and last name, position as contractor, Navy, and sponsor as (b) (6). S/ALEXIS then began to tell the (b) (6) that there were people making noise above him that was preventing him from sleeping,

according to (b) (6). (b) (6) added that S/ALEXIS stated some of the people had a machine which was vibrating his bed and causing him not to be able to get any sleep. (b) (6) noted that S/ALEXIS had a video and audio recording device taped to the ceiling. S/ALEXIS explained he was trying to capture how much noise those above him were making. (b) (6) stated he and (b) (6) told S/ALEXIS that he could not have the recording device taped to the ceiling and that they would check on the noise complaints. (b) (6) stated they also told S/ALEXIS that he should not walk down the hallway and yell at people making the noise, but rather he should call base police to let them know of any disturbances. (b) (6) stated he gave S/ALEXIS the number to NAVSTA Newport, RI Base Police. (b) (6) noted S/ALEXIS was compliant the entire time he and (b) (6) spoke with him and he did not make any indication, verbal or otherwise that he was a threat to himself or others.

3. (b) (6) explained after he and (b) (6) spoke with S/ALEXIS, they went to the second floor of the building to see if there was any noise coming from above S/ALEXIS' room. (b) (6) explained there was not just one room directly above S/ALEXIS' room, but rather two separate rooms. (b) (6) stated he put his ear to one room door while (b) (6) put his ear to the other. (b) (6) explained neither of the (b) (6) heard any sound in the vicinity of the rooms whatsoever. (b) (6) explained they did not go back to talk to S/ALEXIS after checking the second floor. (b) (6) stated he and (b) (6) got back to the Base Police headquarters at around 2200, during shift change. When they returned, according to (b) (6), S/ALEXIS had called back looking for the officers to return. (b) (6) stated officers from the next shift responded to the room at this point.

4. (b) (6) stated he did not contact NCIS at any time regarding the issue. He explained he was not aware of any Base Police personnel who called NCIS regarding S/ALEXIS during this time period.
