## Master Chief Petty Officer (SW/AW/SS) David L. Graham, U.S. Navy Office of the Naval Inspector General's Command Master Chief

Master Chief Graham is a native of Mellwood, Arkansas. Upon graduating from Central High School in 1988, he enlisted in the Navy. He has attended several Navy technical schools, is a graduate of the KEYSTONE, MCPON ELS, CMC/COB Course, Senior Enlisted Academy, and holds an Associate of Science degree in General Studies from Tidewater Community College and a Bachelor of Science from Excelsior College.

Master Chief Graham has been stationed at numerous duty stations in myriad positions of increased responsibility. His duty stations include USS BALTIMORE SSN 704 as a junior auxiliary man qualified as diesel operator, Below Decks watch; Submarine Training Facility Norfolk as an instructor qualifying as Master Training Specialist and Course Supervisor for diesel operator, diesel maintenance, O2 generator; USS NORFOLK SSN 714 as Auxiliary Division LPO qualified as Diving Officer of the Watch, Chief of the Watch and also auxiliary machinery room watch. He also was selected to the rank of Chief Petty Officer; USS NEWPORT NEWS as the Auxiliary Division LCPO and Maintenance Integration Center Supervisor; Commander Submarine Atlantic Fleet as the Force Auxiliary responsible for logistical support of all east coast submarine units; USS HYMAN G. RICKOVER as the 3M Coordinator. He was also selected as a Senior Chief Petty Officer; Commander Amphibious Squadron Eight as the Senior Enlisted Leader stationed onboard the USS KEARSARGE LHD 3; USS KAUFFMAN FFG 59 as the Command Master Chief; Strike Fighter Squadron Eight One of Carrier Air Wing Seventeen onboard USS CARL VINSON CVN 70 as Command Master Chief; Joint Region Marianas as the Region Command Master Chief.



Master Chief Graham is currently serving as Command Master Chief at the Office of Naval Inspector General, Washington Navy Yard, District of Columbia.

Master Chief Graham's personal decorations include Meritorious Service Medal (3 awards), Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (3 awards), Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (2 awards) and numerous unit awards.
