SUBJECT: Rescission of Class Deviation - Temporary Postponement of the Requirement for Debarring and Suspending Officials to Enter Data on an Administrative Agreement in the Federal Awardee Performance and Integrity Information System (FAPIS)

By the attached memorandum dated November 8, 2010, the Director of Defense Procurement and Acquisition Policy (DPAP) rescinded class deviation 2010-O0009. The class deviation was necessary to temporarily postpone the requirement for debarring and suspending officials to enter data on an administrative agreement in the Federal Awardee Performance and Integrity Information System (FAPIS) pursuant to FAR 9.406-3(f) and 9.407-3(e). FAPIS is now ready to accommodate the required data.

The class deviation was necessary to postpone the requirement that debarring and suspending officials enter the information regarding administrative agreements into FAPIS, as required by FAR 9.406-3(f) and 9.407-3(e). In the first phase of implementation, the system was not yet ready to accommodate the data. The template for storage of this data has now been incorporated into FAPIS.
