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

1	Deletion	Deletes text related to issuance of a contracting officer warrants to an individual which is addressed in 5201.603, Selection, appointment and termination of appointment. Delegation of contracting authority occurs at an HCA to HCA level. The breadth of HCA contracting authority assignments covers all organizations and employees within the Department of the Navy which eliminates the need to delegate HCA contracting authority to an individual or non-HCA Navy organization. 2	Clarification	Clarifies text for delegation tracking by changing the word "organization" to "HCA" because contracting authority delegation occurs at an HCA to HCA level.	5201.601-90(a)(1)
3	Deletion	Deletes the text associated with delegation of contracting authority to an individual. Contracting officer appointment and warrant issuance is addressed in 5201.603, Selection, appointment and termination of appointment.	5201.601-90(a)(2)

5	Clarification	Clarifies that DASN(AP) approval is required before an HCA can delegate their unique contracting authority when the delegation ultimately leads to a procurement contracted by a non-Navy activity.	5201.601-90(a)(3)
6	Deletion	Deletes text associated with delegation of contracting authority to an individual. Contracting officer appointment and warrant issuance is addressed in 5201.603, Selection, appointment and termination of appointment.	5201.601-90(a)(3)

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9	Deletion	Deletes text in this subsection related to issuing a contracting officer warrant to an individual. Text is moved to 5201.603, Selection, appointment and termination of appointment which addresses Contracting officer appointment and warrant issuance.	5201.601-90(a)(3)(ii)
10	Clarification	Aligns wording with revised Annex 11 title.	5201.601-90(a)(3)(ii)
11	Deletion	Deletes wording specific to submission of a waiver relevant to an individual's appointment as a warranted contracting officer which is no longer relevant.	5201.601-90(a)(3)(ii)
12	Clarification	Clarifies that delegation of contracting authority occurs HCA to HCA so both the delegating and receiving HCAs are aware of the transfer of responsibility and workload associated with the delegation.	5201.601-90(a)(4)

14	Addition	Adds requirement to submit a copy of signed contracting authority delegations to DASN(AP).	5201.601-90(a)(4)
15	Modification	Modifies 5201.601-90(b) by splitting (b) <i>HCA unique contracting authorities, responsibilities, and limitations</i> into (b) <i>HCA responsibilities and limitations</i> and (c) <i>HCA unique contracting authorities</i> to allow for additional formatting to improve readability.	5201.601-90(b)
16	Modification	Moves the sentence "Delegation of contracting authority applies only to Department of the Navy (DON) activities." forward in the paragraph.	5201.601-90(b)
17	Clarification	Clarifies that an HCA seeking to procure supplies and services outside their unique contracting authority shall obtain written approval for delegation of contracting authority from the cognizant HCA holding the unique contracting authority before conducting the procurement.	5201.601-90(b)(1)
18	Clarification	Clarifies that an HCA request for delegation of contracting authority document the rationale for the request and address how the delegation is necessary.	5201.601-90(b)(1)(i)

21	Modification	Modifies 5201.601-90(b) by splitting (b) <i>HCA unique contracting authorities, responsibilities; and limitations</i> into (b) <i>HCA responsibilities and limitations</i> and (c) <i>HCA unique contracting authorities</i> to allow for additional formatting to improve readability.	5201.601-90(c)
22	Deletion	Deletes “or DoN organization” because DoN contracting authority delegations occur HCA to HCA.	5201.601-90(c)(6)(ii)
22	Clarification	Changes the title to Annex 11 from “ Delegation of Contracting Authority—Organization not within HCA Cognizance ” to “ Delegation of Contracting Authority ”. Deletes “or office”. Opening paragraph addresses contracting authority delegations occurring HCA to HCA for procurement ultimately contracted by a non-Navy activity. All changes align with delegation occurring Navy HCA to Navy HCA.	Annex 11
23	Addition	Adds Part IV, Describe Qualifications of Personnel Exercising Contracting Authority (Contracting Officer(s)) and moves Part I, g. Grade/Rank and h. Special Qualifications to Part IV reflecting the need for the HCA decision on delegating authority to include awareness of the skills, training and experience of the individual(s) exercising the delegated contracting authority. 24	Addition	Reinserts a retitled Annex 12, Waiver Request for Appointing a Non-DON Employee as a Contracting Officer . Annex 12 does not apply to DoN as the breadth of HCA assignments covers all organizations and employees in the Department.	Annex 12
