

SUBJECT: Class Deviation – Permanent Authority for Use of Simplified Acquisition Procedures for Certain Commercial Items

The attached Director, Defense Procurement and Acquisition Policy (DPAP) memorandum of December 24, 2014 is forwarded for your information and action, as appropriate. The Class Deviation implements section 815 of the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) of Fiscal Year 2015. DPAP has advised that effective immediately, contracting officers shall use the attached deviation from Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 13.5, Test Program for Certain Commercial Items. Currently, FAR 13.500(d) indicates that the authority to issue solicitations under subpart 13.5 expires on January 1, 2015. However, section 815 of the NDAA makes the authority permanent.
