SUBJECT: Civilian Nominations for the 2014-2015 Senior Acquisition Course (SAC) at the Dwight D. Eisenhower School for National Security and Resource Strategy (formerly ICAF)

Nominations are now being accepted for the Dwight D. Eisenhower School for National Security and Resource Strategy (formerly the Industrial College of the Armed Forces) Senior Acquisition Course (SAC) for the 2014-2015 academic year (August 2014 – June 2015) and are due by **7 March 2014**. Department of Navy has received **7** quotas for DON civilian acquisition professionals.

The Eisenhower School is a preeminent one-year strategic leadership course for members of the Department of Defense Acquisition, Technology and Logistics workforce. Those who graduate are awarded a Master of Science Degree in National Resource Strategy, fulfills DAU-ACQ 401 course and can also fulfill PMT 401. Although there is no tuition for this course, nominating organizations must fund travel and per diem as applicable throughout the academic school year. (Tuition may be applicable if someone is selected as an alternate candidate and is later granted a seat as an additional DON quota.) All nominees must have, at minimum, a National Agency Check with Inquires (NACI) completed prior to their arrival. Candidates who fail to provide the requested security clearance information on the nomination form will not be considered for enrollment.


This call is for civilian acquisition workforce nominations from Echelon I and II acquisition commands (see distribution). All nominations require Flag/General Officer, or SES command-level endorsement. Commands nominating more than one candidate are asked to rank-order your nominations. Further guidance and applications forms are attached.
