Kristine R. Boyles serves as the Director, Surface Systems Contracts Division, Naval Sea Systems Command (NAVSEA). Ms. Boyles is responsible for leading a team of contracting professionals to plan, negotiate, award, and provide contractual oversight of the Nation's most complex weapons systems in support of ACAT I through IV and non-ACAT rated Defense Programs. Her duties involve the obligation and expenditure of an estimated \$4 to \$6 billion annually executing in excess of 1,000 contracting actions in support of Program Executive Office Integrated Warfare Systems (PEO IWS).

Prior to selection as Director, Surface Systems Contracts, Ms. Boyles served as the Deputy Director, Surface Systems Contracts Division as well as Contracts Branch Head, Surface Ship Repair at NAVSEA. She was instrumental in planning and executing NAVSEA's Surface Ship Modernization and Contracting Strategy transitioning from Multi-Ship Multi-Option (MSMO) contracts to a Firm Fixed price strategy resulting in significant realized savings to the fleet.

Prior to NAVSEA, Ms. Boyles served as Deputy Director, Contracts and Business Management, Military Sealift Command (MSC) executing \$1.5 billion of MSC's \$2.5 billion operating expenses and processing 7,000 contracting actions annually. Ms. Boyles was responsible for directing and coordinating major procurement operations involving the planning, negotiating, awarding and contract administration for ship repair and services and supplies for the USNS Fleet (averaging 100 vessels) in support of MSC's ocean transportation mission to include prepositioning, strategic sealift, and special missions. Additionally, she was responsible for all aspects of the contracts directorate administration, from budget execution to human capital strategy development, along with overarching acquisition policy and process implementation.

Ms. Boyles' Navy contracting career began as a Contract Specialist in the Navy Career Management Center's Distinguished Scholar Intern Program in 1989 and includes serving at: Fleet and Industrial Supply Center, San Diego; Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command Headquarters; Naval Facilities Engineering Command, San Diego; Fleet and Industrial Supply Center, Yokosuka, Japan; and Naval Regional Contracting Center (NRCC), San Diego.

Ms. Boyles was appointed to the Senior Executive Service in August 2019 and has 30 years of civilian service. She received her Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration from Frostburg State University and her Master of Business Administration degree from National University. Ms. Boyles is a member of the Acquisition Professional Community and is Level III certified in the Contracting career field.
