Mr. Tony Brock assumed the duties as the Navy Senior Language Authority (OPNAV N13F) and Director, Navy Language, Regional Expertise, and Culture (LREC) Office upon his appointment to the Defense Intelligence Senior level (DISL) in November 2020. He's served as a Navy enlisted Sailor, Navy Intelligence Officer, and DoN / DoD Civilian for over 35 years.

As a civilian, Mr. Brock previously served at the Office of Naval Intelligence as the Executive Director, Brooks Center for Maritime Engagement; Director, Middle-East Regional Support Activity (DoD) in Manama, Bahrain; and as a Senior Staff Officer in Civil-Military Security Affairs in Kabul, Afghanistan.

As a U.S. Navy Commander (O-5) (Intelligence Officer) (Ret), Mr. Brock's previous operational and staff tours include: U.S. Naval Attaché to Hong Kong and Macau, China; Deputy Assistant Chief of Staff for Intelligence, Naval Special Warfare Development Group; J2 Chief of Operations and Strike Force J2 Joint Special Operations Command (JSOC) deployed to Afghanistan and Iraq; as J2 Special Operations Command Central (SOCCENT-Bahrain), to include deployment to Aden, Yemen following the attack against USS Cole (DDG-67). He served as an Intelligence Officer with Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe (SHAPE) and Allied Command Counterintelligence Center (ACCI) in Belgium; NAVCENT/5th Fleet in Bahrain; and SEAL Delivery Vehicle Team TWO (SDVT-2).

As an enlisted sailor, he served as Submarine Sonar Technician First-Class (E-6) aboard USS Haddock (SSN-621) in support of Pacific operations, USS Orion (AS-18) in Italy, and ashore as the Navy's Recruiter-of-the-Year for NRD New England.

Mr. Brock has earned a Master of Business Administration (MBA) degree from University of Maryland Global University, a B.A. in International Relations from University of Florida, graduated from U.S. Army Basic Parachutist Course, Joint Military
