### **Assistant Deputy Director Naval Intelligence**

Ms. Sandra Brown is the Assistant Deputy Director of Naval Intelligence and the Deputy Director, Naval Intelligence Activity in the Information Warfare Directorate on the Chief Naval Operations Staff. She assists the Deputy Director of Naval Intelligence in the development and dissemination of intelligence support for Navy senior leaders, oversight, and management of Navy intelligence programs and the daily management of the Naval Intelligence Activity, an Echelon II organization. Ms. Brown was appointed to the Defense Intelligence Executive Service position in March 2019.

From May 2016 to February 2018 Ms. Brown served as the Deputy Director of the Telecommunications and Networks Research Group at the National Security Agency where her team conducted both classified and unclassified networking and computing research. Ms. Brown's mission focus was cyber security while she continued to support cognitive diversity in the field of scientific research.

Ms. Brown's previous position at the Office of Naval Intelligence, and served as the Assistant Director for Technical Intelligence. She initiated and led analytical deep-dives on operational and emerging threat technologies with a focus on foreign underwater systems including submarines, weapons, and autonomous underwater vehicles.

Ms. Brown has degrees in mathematics, electrical engineering, and National Resource Strategy and is an International Coaching Federation certified executive coach.
