### **Strategic Advisor for Plans and Programs Naval Intelligence Activity**

Ms. Megan Dane is the Strategic Advisor for Plans and Programs, Naval Intelligence Activity on the Deputy Chief of Naval Operations for Information Warfare (N2N6) staff. She is responsible for high-level strategic plans and programs within Naval Intelligence and advises the Deputy Director of Naval Intelligence (DDNI) on strategy and policy related issues involving the Intelligence Community (IC), Naval Intelligence Enterprise, and the Information Warfare Community. She represents Naval Intelligence interests on DoD and IC Functional Management Committees. Ms. Dane was appointed as a Defense Intelligence Senior Level in March 2020.

Ms. Dane's previous positions include Director, Acquisition and Contracts at the Office of Naval Intelligence (ONI) and Senior Advisor for OSINT and DOMEX at the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI). She began her career as a Surface Warfare Officer (2003-2007) and has held numerous analytic, production, and collections office leadership positions at ONI. She has initiated and led operational IC deep-dives on the use of publicly available information and data management standards.

Ms. Dane graduated from Tulane University with a BA and MA in English in 2003 and holds a Master of Science, Library Science from the University of North Texas.
