### **Director, Unmanned Aviation & Strike Weapons Procurement Department Naval Air Systems Command**

Ms. Geiger entered the Senior Executive Service in July 2019, assigned as the Director, Unmanned Aviation & Strike Weapons Procurement Department. In this role, she is the senior procurement official responsible for the contracting activities of the naval aviation programs assigned to the Program Executive Office for Unmanned Aviation and Strike Weapons (PEO(U&W)).

Prior to her current assignment, Ms. Geiger served as the Deputy Director, Common & Commercial Systems for Naval Air Systems Command (NAVAIR). She supported the Director in executive oversight of five program offices, delivering common aircrew, training, communication, support equipment, and commercial air services systems to the Fleet. The programs execute \$1.6 billion in appropriated funds per year through more than 80 programs assigned to the NAVAIR Commander.

Ms. Geiger joined NAVAIR in 1997 and has had multiple contracting and program management positions spanning development, flight test, production, and sustainment support of fixed wing, helicopter, weapons, and commodity programs. She spent 7 and a half years in the contracting department with increasing levels of responsibility, culminating as a Contracting Officer with an unlimited warrant for the F/A-18E/F, EA-18G, and Sigma/ERP program offices. Previous program management assignments include Principal Deputy Program Manager (PDPM) for the Navy and Marine Corps Multi-Mission Tactical Unmanned Air Systems Program Office, PDPM for Strike Planning and Execution Systems Program Office, Integrated Product Team Leader (IPTL) for the Advanced Anti-Radiation Guided Missile (AARGM) program, and IPTL for In-Service Weapons. She also served as the Action Officer for naval UAS programs for Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Navy, Air Programs (DASN(Air)), and Acquisition Manager for PEO(U&W) programs.

Ms. Geiger holds a bachelor's degree from Frostburg State University with a major in business administration, and minors in economics and mathematics; and a master's degree of business administration from Florida Institute of Technology. She is DAU Level III certified in Contracting and Program Management.
