## **John W. Graveen**



### **Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Navy (Financial Policy and Systems)**

John Graveen currently serves as the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Navy, Financial Policy and Systems. In this position, he is responsible for Department of the Navy policy and systems for budgeting, accounting and financial management. He also has responsibility for the financial management community human capital program.

A retired Navy submariner, he served in USS Dace, USS Jack, USS Greenling, USS Lafayette (Gold), and USS Providence and commanded USS Hawkbill. While ashore Mr. Graveen served in comptroller, programming, and nuclear engineering assignments.

After retiring from active duty, Mr Graveen managed information technology and consulting programs at a small government services company. He entered civil service as the Director of the Navy's Strategic Sourcing Program, overseeing process efficiency programs. Subsequently he served as the Deputy in the Navy's Programming Branch, where he coordinated the Navy's Future Year's Defense Program and directed the data systems associated with the Navy's program and budget. Mr. Graveen then served as the Director for Program and Financial Control within the Under Secretary of Defense (Comptroller). There he was responsible for collecting, reviewing and submitting the Defense budget and monitoring and reporting its execution. He was also responsible for the information technology systems used in these processes.

Mr. Graveen holds a Bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Wisconsin-Madison and a Master's degree in Computer Systems from the Naval Postgraduate School.
