Special Agent Andrew J. Lochli is a senior executive with the Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS) and serves as the Director of the Office of Commercial and Economic Analysis – Navy (OCEAN), Naval Intelligence Activity. OCEAN enables the defense of Department of the Navy equities by identifying, characterizing and highlighting economic threats through all-source intelligence analysis and information sharing while developing actionable mitigation plans in support of the National Defense Strategy. Special Agent Lochli serves as the principal advisor to the Director NCIS, the Deputy Director of Naval Intelligence, and other senior Department of the Navy leaders on OCEAN-related matters. He was appointed to the Defense Intelligence Senior Level (DISL) in October 2018.

Special Agent Lochli served previously as the Assistant Director, NCIS Cyber Directorate (2016-2018) where he provided direction, oversight and coordination of criminal and counterintelligence investigations and operations occurring in the cyber domain. Additionally, he was responsible for program management, analytics, forensic support and cyber innovation for the NCIS enterprise.

His former senior leadership positions include serving as Deputy Assistant Director (DAD) for Cyber Program Management (2016); DAD for Criminal Investigations and Operations (2014-2016); Executive Assistant to the Deputy Director (2013-2014); DAD for National Security Investigations (2013); and Division Chief for Criminal Operations and Transnational Crimes (2013).

Special Agent Lochli's prior supervisory positions include serving as Assistant Special Agent in Charge (ASAC) of the Northwest Field Office (2009-2011); and ASAC of the Hawaii Field Office (2008-2009). He previously served as the Supervisory Special Agent (SSA) of the NCIS Resident Agency, Kaneohe Bay, Hawaii (2008-2009), SSA Office of Special Projects (2007-2008) and SSA NCIS Counterintelligence Directorate (2005).

Special Agent Lochli joined NCIS in 1999 with initial assignments in Bremerton, Washington and Marianas, Guam. In these locations he conducted the full spectrum of the NCIS general crimes and counterintelligence missions before transferring to NCIS Headquarters in 2004.

Special Agent Lochli earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree from Drew University where he majored in Political Science and minored in Sociology. He earned a Master of Arts Degree from The George Washington University where he majored in Criminal Justice with an emphasis in Security Management.
