## Christopher A. Miller



### **Assistant Deputy Chief of Naval Operations for Information Warfare (OPNAV N2N6B)**



Mr. Miller serves as the Assistant Deputy Chief of Naval Operations for Information Warfare, managing requirements, policy and resources for Communications, Networks, ISR, Oceanography, Space, Cyber, Electronic Warfare, and Command and Control capabilities. Mr. Miller leads the strategy, planning, programming, budgeting and execution for investments of over \$9 billion dollars per year in more than 200 Navy programs and 52,000 military, civilian and contractor personnel. Additionally, he oversees the Navy service's Chief Information and Cybersecurity Offices.

Appointed to the Senior Executive Service in May 2006, Mr. Miller served in various roles at Naval Information Warfare Center Atlantic, including most recently as Executive Director from 2016-2019. In this role, he set command-wide strategy and managed engineering and business operations for more than 4,500 civilian and military employees and approximately 9,000 industry partners. Mr. Miller earlier served as the Program Executive Officer (PEO) for the DoD Healthcare Management System and as the Navy's PEO for Command, Control, Communications, Computers and Intelligence. He started his federal civilian service in 2001 at the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command as a systems engineer.

Prior to joining federal service, Mr. Miller worked at Booz Allen Hamilton in San Diego, where he supported Navy command and control programs.

In 1995, Mr. Miller graduated from Vanderbilt University with a Bachelor's degree in American history and political science. There he completed the Naval Reserve Officer Training Corps and received commission as a Marine Corps intelligence officer. Mr. Miller completed a deployment to the Western Pacific and supported Operation Southern Watch. He is certified Level III in program management and holds a Systems Engineering Certification from the University of California, San Diego.
