Director, Procurement for Tactical Aircraft and Weapons Programs (PEO(T)) Naval Air Systems Command

Ms. Peters was appointed to the Senior Executive Service in October 2020, as the Director, Procurement Group for Tactical Aircraft and Weapons Programs (PEO(T)), Naval Air Systems Command (NAVAIR). In this role, she is the senior procurement official responsible for the contracting activities of the naval aviation programs assigned to the PEO(T) business portfolio, overseeing the execution of over 1,200 actions and more than \$7B annually in hardware and services.

Prior to this appointment, Ms. Peters served for over 7 years as a Division Head for Tactical Aircraft Contracts supporting the F/A-18 and EA-18G Program Office (PMA-265) at NAVAIR. During this time, she was the Lead Procuring Contracting Officer (PCO) managing a team of 40 PCOs and contracts specialists responsible for procuring over \$3B annually in support of F/A-18 A-D, F/A-18E/F and EA-18G hardware and service products; retrofit installations; weapons integration; support of seven Foreign Military Sales partner countries; Service Life Extension modification and readiness efforts; Flight Plan Capability Development; and Depot Level Repair and Maintenance activities.

Ms. Peters began her 21-year civilian career in procurement supporting base operations service contracts for the Naval Air Warfare Center Aircraft Division, and in 2001 moved to NAVAIR Headquarters supporting Program Management programs, becoming a warranted contracting officer in 2006. From 2007-2010 Ms. Peters supported the F/A-18 Program Office in the role of PCO for the 3rd multi-year production contract, negotiated for over \$5B, and the first major weapons system to incorporate the original Better Buying Power tenets. From 2010-2012 she served in various PCO roles supporting the E-2D Hawkeye program with their second low rate initial production procurement and the Naval Undergraduate Flight Training Systems Program Office supporting the T-45 platform.

Ms. Peters is a recipient of the Department of the Navy (DON) Superior Civilian Service Award, the PMA-265 Ned Conger Award, the DON Acquisition Excellence Award, several NAVAIR Commander's National Awards, and a NAVAIR Small Business Award.

Ms. Peters holds a bachelor's of arts degree with Honors in english literature from Boston College, and a master's of business administration degree from the University of Maryland University College.
