Ms. Riker entered the Senior Executive Service in June 2020. She is currently the senior civilian at U.S. Fleet Forces Command responsible for directing the design, implementation, and management of programs to align Fleet activities in accordance with environmental statutes, as well as overseeing Fleet installation and energy portfolios. Prior to this assignment, Ms. Riker served as the U.S. Fleet Forces Command Deputy Director, Fleet Installations and Environment (July 2017 to June 2020) and Environmental Resources and Planning Branch Head / Principal Advisor to the Environmental Readiness Division Head (January 2014 to July 2017). In 2013, Ms. Riker retired from the U.S. Navy as a Captain in the Judge Advocate General's Corps.

Ms. Riker commissioned as an Ensign in the U. S. Navy Judge Advocate General's Corps in July 1992. During her 21-year naval career, Ms. Riker served as trial counsel, legal assistance attorney, and defense counsel at Naval Legal Service Offices in Washington D.C., Bremerton, Washington and Norfolk, Virginia. Ms. Riker served in several operational law billets to include Staff Judge Advocate onboard USS Samuel Gompers (AD-37) where she made a Western-Pacific deployment, Amphibious Group Two where she deployed onboard the USS Kearsarge (LHD-3) in support of Operations Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom and U.S. Fifth Fleet in Manama, Bahrain during Operation Desert Strike. Ms. Riker also served on several legal staffs including Naval Submarine Base Bangor, Navy Region Mid-Atlantic, U.S. Fleet Forces Command as environmental counsel and Submarine Forces Atlantic.

Ms. Riker holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Political Science, a Juris Doctor degree from Seton Hall Law School and a Masters in Environmental Law from the George Washington University Law School. In 2016, Ms. Riker received a Graduate Certificate in Public Sector Leadership from Old Dominion University in Norfolk, Virginia.

Ms. Riker's other awards include the Legion of Merit, Meritorious Service Medal (four awards), Navy Commendation Medal (three awards), Navy Achievement Medal (two awards), and is authorized to wear various other service medals and ribbons.
