## Samuel G. Worth



### Deputy Director Naval Criminal Investigative Service

Special Agent Worth was selected as the Deputy Director of the Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS) in 2016. He serves as the agency's Chief Operations Officer with responsibility for eight agency directorates: Criminal Investigations, National Security, Intelligence and Information Sharing, Cyber, Management and Administration, Global Operations, Atlantic Operations, and Pacific Operations.

Prior to his current assignment, Special Agent Worth served as the Principal Executive Assistant Director for Management and Administration, with responsibility for the daily oversight and management of agency business operations, including finance, human capital, logistics, acquisition, administration, planning and evaluation, and information technology functions (2011-2016). His prior executive leadership positions include serving as Executive Assistant Director (EAD) for Criminal Investigations (2010-2011); and EAD for the Middle East and Pacific Operations (2009-2010). He was promoted to the Senior Executive Service in 2009.

Special Agent Worth's prior senior managerial positions include serving as the Special Agent in Charge of the NCIS Norfolk Field Office, Norfolk, Virginia (2006-2009); and Division Chief and Deputy Assistant Director for NCIS Protective Operations, Washington, D.C. (2004-2006).

Special Agent Worth began his career in 1989 with the former Naval Investigative Service at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. He served in a variety of assignments and mission areas, both within the United States and overseas, including Special Agent Afloat, deployed aboard USS America (CV 66) (1993-1994); Desk Officer at NCIS Headquarters, Washington, D.C. (1998-2000); Supervisory Special Agent, NCIS Resident Agency, Sigonella, Italy (2000-2003); and Personal Security Advisor to the Secretary of the Navy, Washington, D.C. (2003-2004).

Special Agent Worth earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Criminal Justice, graduating *magna cum laude*, from Norwich University in Northfield, Vermont in 1987. He completed the Department of Defense Senior Executive APEX Session 38 (2014), and is a graduate of the FBI National Executive Institute, Session XXXV(2012). His awards include the Department of the Navy (DON) Distinguished Civilian Service Award, the DON Superior Civilian Service Award, and the DON Meritorious Civilian Service Award.
