 - a. Budget Overview
 - The Fiscal Year 2018 (FY 2018) baseline budget submission for the Department of the navy (DON) is \$171.5B. The FY 2018 President's Budget balances current readiness needed to execute assigned missions while sustaining a highly capable fleet. The DON budget balances risk in today's requirements and those required to counter 21st century threats.

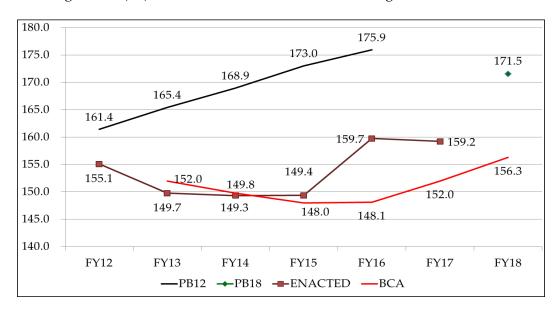

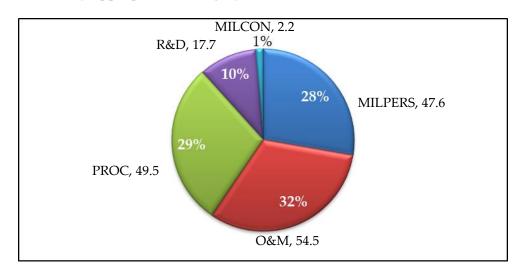
Highlights include:

- 24 F-35B/C, 14 F/A-18E/F, 5 E-2D, 7 P-8A, 2 KC-130J, 22 AH-1Z, 4 CH-53K, 6 CMV-22, 4 RQ-21, and 3 MQ-4C.
- Military basic pay and civilian pay increased by 2.0% and 1.9% respectively.
- Battle force ship count is 292 in FY 2018
- Ship depot maintenance funding to 100%
- Ship operations funded to support 58 underway days per quarter for deployed forces and 24 days per quarter for non-deployed forces
- Navy/Marine Corps flying hours budgeted at T-2.0

- Percentage required maintenance funded in base and OCO in FY2018: Ship Depot: 100%, Aviation Depot: 89%, Marine Corps ground equipment: 79%. Sustainment of shore facilities is funded at 78% of requirement for Navy and 75% for Marine Corps.

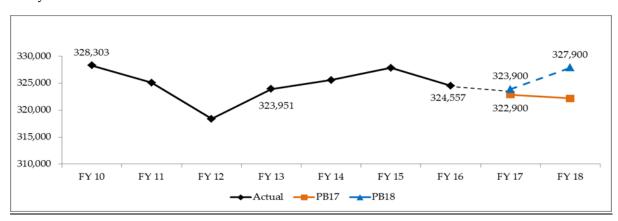

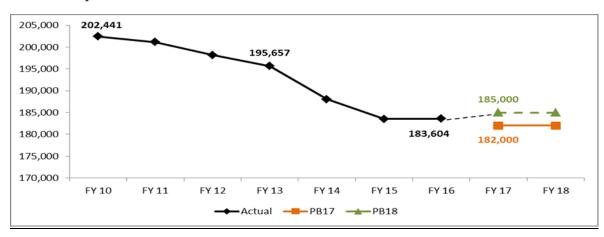
