
Subj: INTEGRATED DISABILITY EVALUATION SYSTEM PROCEDURAL UPDATES

Ref: (a) SECNAVINST 1850.4E
(b) ASN (M&RA) Memorandum of 27 Jan 12 (Integrated Disability Evaluation System
– (IDES) Trainees, Recruits, and Cadets)

1. Purpose: To provide updated procedural guidance in accordance with reference (a) and to implement reference (b).

2. Disability Evaluation System (DES) Cases Involving Trainees, Recruits, and Cadets.

Reference (b) authorized the processing of DES Legacy procedures for enlisted Initial Entry Training (IET) service members. IET service members are those members in basic military or recruit training (boot camp). Those IET service members identified by the DES referring Medical Treatment Facility (MTF) as having a questionably unfitting condition, and identified as such will be adjudicated by the Physical Evaluation Board under the DES Legacy procedures. PEBLOs shall ensure the referring MTFs enroll IET service members in the Veterans Administration Benefits Delivery at Discharge/Quick Start Programs. Cases received by the PEB without enrollment verification will not be processed under DES Legacy procedures and may be returned to the submitting MTF.
